TO: All Agents
RE: E-Quote login change effective July 1, 2011

On July 1, 2011 the web address for E-Quote will be changed from:

- <http://quote.twia.org/twia/do/login>, (For use prior to July 1, 2011) to
- <https://quote.twia.org/twia/do/login>. (For use on or after July 1, 2011).

This means that if you currently use the old E-Quote login through use of a “saved” bookmark or “favorite”, it will not work after June 30. You will need to update it to the new URL address mentioned above to access E-Quote on or after July 1.

If you routinely access E-Quote by using the Agent Login button at www.twia.org, you will not notice any changes and your login to E-Quote should work.

What should I do now?

You should not take any action prior to July 1. You can continue to use your saved bookmark or the Agent Login button on the TWIA website to get to E-Quote through June 30.

What should I do on July 1?

To access E-Quote on July 1 (or the first time you login after this date), you will need to click the Agent Login button from the home page of www.twia.org, or type <https://quote.twia.org/twia/do/login> in the address field of your browser window. You can then save this new address as a bookmark or favorite to use on or after July 1, and delete the old address.

Why is TWIA changing the agent login address?

TWIA is changing the protocol portion of the E-Quote address from ‘http’ to ‘https’ to increase your security when transmitting sensitive information over the internet. The added ‘s’ in the address line indicates that the information you transmit is being encrypted.
