Weston's Insolvency Timeline

- August 8, 2022: Weston placed into receivership and ordered into liquidation by Florida Office of Insurance Regulation
- Notice to agents and policyholders that all policies cancelled effective September 7, 2022

Identifying Concerns

- Approximately 30,000 property owners in Texas potentially without coverage
- Peak of hurricane season
- Receivership and liquidation proceedings uncertainty around timing of unearned premium refunds
- How can TWIA fulfill its mission, work within the existing legal and regulatory framework, and provide relief to Weston policyholders?

Communication and Collaboration

- External and internal communication plan
 - Agent bulletins, FAQ, webpage, customer service group
- Began daily meetings with Texas Department of Insurance August 16
- Worked to identify simplest process changes that would provide Weston policyholders the clearest avenue to coverage if unable to find elsewhere
 - Timing of application and payment
 - Storm moratorium

Emergency Rule


- Issued August 23
- Provides relief on three fronts:
 - Storm moratorium
 - Application timing
 - Payment timing

Weston Statistics


Approximately 30,000 Texas policyholders

- Approximately 23,000 within TWIA designated catastrophe area and 7,000 inland
- Approximately 21,000 wind and hail only
- Approximately 20,000 of those wind and hail only are residential and approximately 1,000 commercial

TWIA New Business Trends

- 2,119 TWIA new policies issued in August listing Weston as the declining carrier as of 8/30/2022
 - 78 commercial
 - 2,041 residential
 - Out of 12,343 total new policies issued in August
